



Rama Swim Club is all about fun and community but we also have to make sure everyone is staying safe. Here are a few rules to keep in mind while enjoying the club this summer.

General Conduct

1. All members and guests are expected to maintain decorum and not be disruptive when at Rama Swim Club. The club reserves the right to remove members from the club who fail to abide by these rules.
2. While at the club, parents are asked to prevent their children from playing in the office area, running in office or pool deck areas or wandering unsupervised in any areas of the club.
3. Children under the age of 10 (turns 10 prior to 9/1) must be accompanied by an adult when they enter the club.
4. Children must be 14 (turns 14 prior to 9/1) years or older to babysit an unaccompanied child under the age of 10.
5. Any member (members are responsible for guests), who litters, vandalizes or causes malicious mischief in or on pool property will immediately rectify the damage, pay all costs necessary to rectify any damage, and/or accept suspension or revocation of membership.
6. All members and their guests must sign in at the front desk.
7. Emergency telephone is located at the front desk.
8. A first aid kit is located at the front desk.
9. Alcohol use is permitted by members and their guests, provided they are over 21 years old. NO GLASS of any kind is permitted.
10. Rama Swim Club is 100% Smoke Free – no cigarettes, cigars, e-cigarettes or the like. Smoking is only allowed in the grassy median of the parking lot. Please dispose of cigarettes/cigars properly.
11. Members and guests are expected to clean up after themselves by using the trash and recycling containers provided.

Guest Policy

1. Guests are defined as any non-member on the premises of Rama Swim Club. This includes pool guests (swimmers and non-swimmers), Tennis guests and volleyball guests (excluding guests registered for active league).
2. Every member is provided with guest passes. Once those passes are consumed, all guests must pay the fees listed below.

4. All guests MUST pay a guest fee and be accompanied with a member in good standing. Guest Fees: \$3/person Monday–Friday & \$5/person weekends and holidays
5. Guests assume all risks for their safety.
6. Members are responsible for ensuring that their guests abide by club rules.

Pool & Deck

1. ADULTS SHOULD NOT SWIM ALONE.
2. CHILDREN SHOULD NOT USE THE SWIMMING POOL WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION.
3. No pets allowed in the pool area.
4. No persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
5. No persons with skin, eye, ear, or nasal infections, abrasions, or rashes allowed in the pool.
6. No persons with communicable disease(s) allowed in the pool.
7. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Owners and management are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
8. NO talking to on-duty lifeguards, unless it involves the safety of the members and guests.
9. NO running, pushing, or horseplay in pool area.
10. Children who are not toilet trained are required to wear a swim diaper at all times. Please see a lifeguard or board member if you need to purchase swim diapers.
11. **Adult Swim:** our certified lifeguards take regularly scheduled breaks. During this time or when there is not a lifeguard on duty, the pool is considered to be swim at your own risk. Children under the age of 18 MAY NOT swim during adult swim or when lifeguards are not on duty.
12. Any skateboards, roller blades, etc are only permitted on the asphalt parking lot of the Club property. Skateboards, roller blades, etc. are not permitted within the pool area, on sidewalks or tennis courts.
13. **Thunder & Lightning Policy:** If thunder or lightning is heard or seen anywhere around the swimming pool area, the

lifeguards are responsible to clear the pool and pool deck area. The pool is then off limits for 30 minutes from last heard thunder or last seen lightning. (*National Lightning Safety Institute*)

Minnow Pond

1. All kiddos 5 years and younger welcome and must be accompanied by an adult.
2. No diving in the minnow pond.
3. Children who are not toilet trained are required to wear a swim diaper at all times. Please see a lifeguard or board member if you need to purchase swim diapers.

Diving Board

1. Only one person allowed on the diving board and the ladder at a time. Those waiting will wait on the pavement.
2. Only one bounce when using the diving board.
3. No flotation devices are allowed in the deep end.
4. No inward diving/jumping.
5. Diving or jumps may be taken only when the diving well is clear of people.
6. Swimmers must be able to swim the width of the deep end without the aid of a flotation device in order to jump from the diving boards or swim in the deep end. Lifeguards may ask swimmers to demonstrate their ability.
7. Diving is only allowed in the deep end of the pool.

Volleyball

1. The volleyball court is for the use of Rama Swim Club members and their guests only.
2. Visitors who have paid registration fees as part of the volleyball leagues are welcome.
3. Volleyball-only memberships are available. See RamaSwimClub.com for more information.
4. All persons using the volleyball court do so at their own risk. Owners and management are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
